## RUNNING YOUR EURO 2016 SWEEPSTAKE

1. Print out the Euro 2016 sweepstake kit, cut out each teams name, fold them in half and then put them into a hat or a container for participants to select their entry.
2. You can charge as much as you like per entry. With 24 competing teams one suggestion would be to charge £2 per team which would give you a total prize fund of £48.
3. Get your friends/colleagues to draw a team's name from the hat or container. It's best to write down who drew which team below to save the hassle of remembering later on.
4. Make sure you manage to sell all of the teams! It's usually a good idea to keep the teams that have already been picked a secret until all the teams have been sold. This reduces the chance of you not being able to sell the poorer teams that could potentially still be left.
5. Once Euro 2016 has been won you're free to distribute the winnings. If you did charge participants £2 per entry as suggested above the prize fund could be split as follows: Euro 2016 Winner: £24, Runner up: £12, 3rd place: £8 and 4th place winning £4. Alternatively, if you just want to reward the finalists, you would give £32 to the winner and £16 to the runner up.
